

St Martin's Parents:

As we prepare for the school year, this letter pertains to health forms. Some forms are required while others are optional.

The following documentation is <u>required</u> for all students:

Immunization Records

Students must have a copy of their updated immunization record on file per state regulations.

- All K-8 students must have had <u>two</u> varicella vaccinations.
- All 7th and 8th grade students must have had <u>one</u> Tdap vaccination and <u>one</u> meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination.

Please see the attached "Vaccine Requirements for Children" document for reference.

- Emergency Contact Form needs to be completed every school year
- Health Assessment I needs to be completed by the student's parent or guardian
- Health Assessment II needs to be completed <u>only</u> by physician or nurse practitioner
- Blood Lead Testing Certificate is needed for all Pre-K, Kindergarten & 1st grade students

* If you previously provided the health assessment & lead testing, there is no need to resubmit.

The following forms are <u>optional</u>:

- Permission to Dispense Over-the-Counter Medications
 - This form grants the school permission to dispense medications that we keep a stock of for your student. This form must be signed by a parent/guardian and a healthcare provider. No over-the-counter medication will be administered without this form. A new form needs to be completed each school year.
- School Medication Administration Authorization Form
 - This form is for medication that needs to be administered daily or on an as-needed basis at school (inhalers, epi-pens, oral medications). This form is to be completed fully and signed by a parent/guardian and a healthcare provider. A new form must be completed at the beginning of the school year for each medication and each time there is a change in dosage or time of administration.
